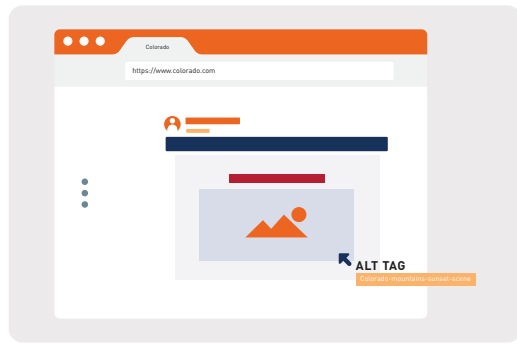


Visual Components



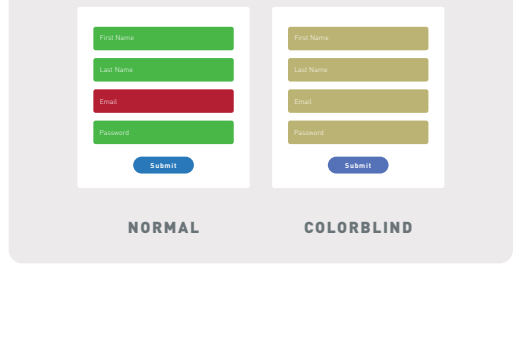
Alternative text is provided for every image, applet, embedded media, plug-in, button link, etc., to convey content and function.



Uses CSS background images for descriptive graphics or have null/empty alt values (alt=""). Images with text



Includes a descriptive caption / page for graphs, charts, etc., or longdesc attribute.



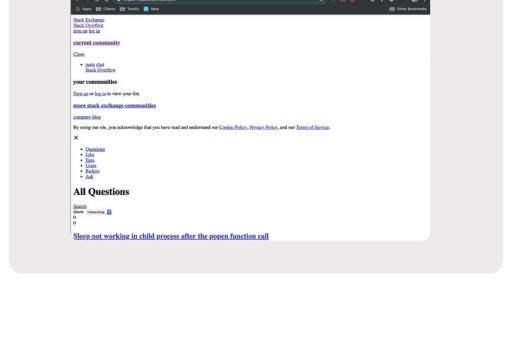
Does not solely rely on color to convey important information.



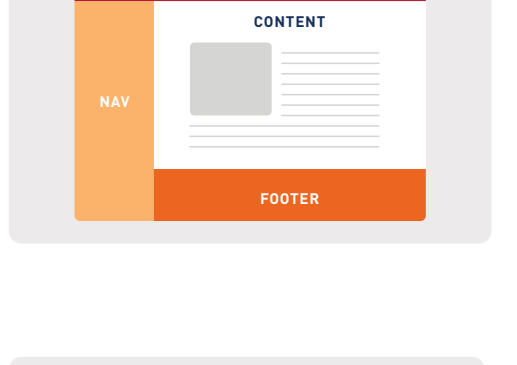
High-contrast mode included.



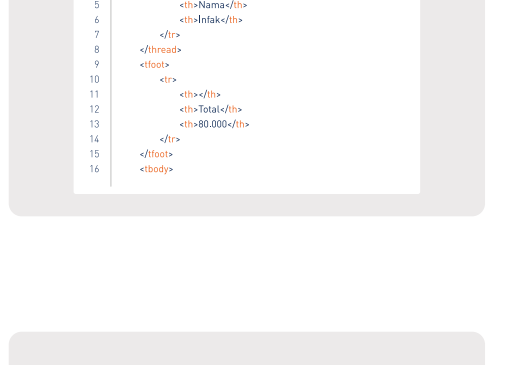
Uses client-side image map (linked information is bundled along with the HTML document).



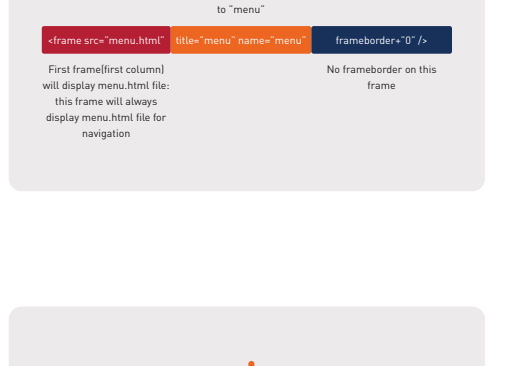
The document is still readable and understandable (even if less visually appealing) when the style sheet is turned off.



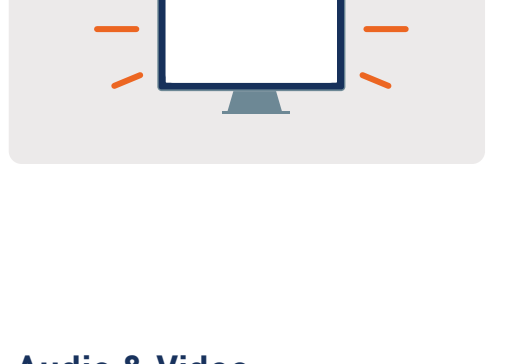
No <th> element used in tables for layout purposes.



Data tables have column and/or row headers appropriately identified (using the <th> element).

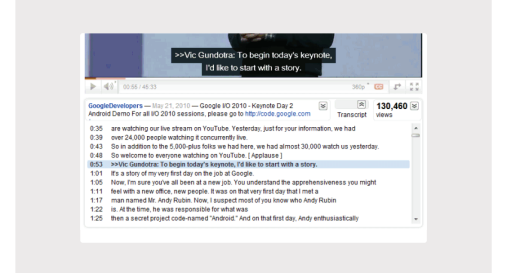


Each frame is given a title that describes the frame's purpose or content.

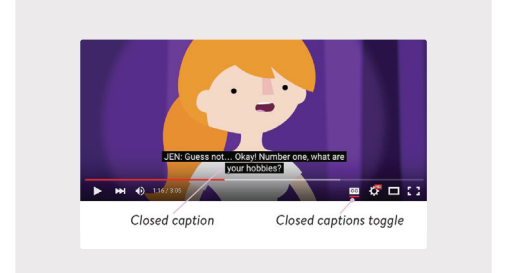


No element on the page flashes with a frequency greater than 2Hz or lower than 55Hz, thus reducing the risk of optically-induced seizures.

Audio & Video

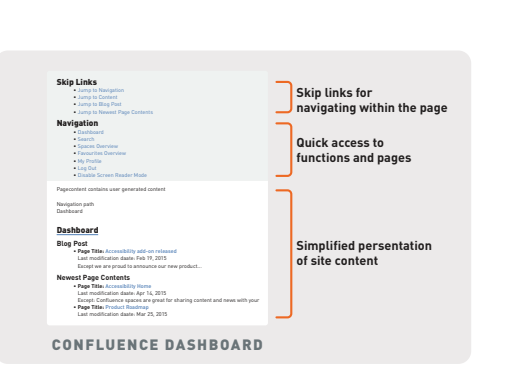


Transcripts are provided for audio content.

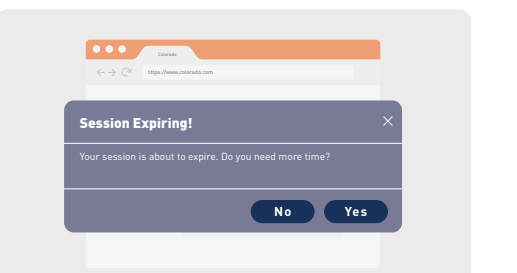


Video files and live audio broadcasts have closed captions enabled.

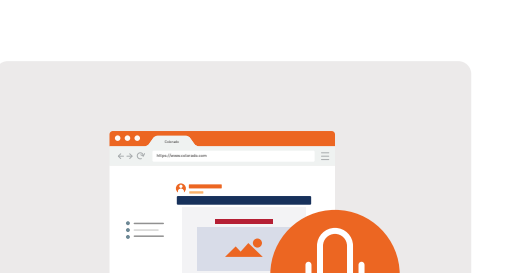
Navigation



Provides skip navigation links for keyboard-only users to enable them to move directly to the information section that they need. A good heading structure also facilitates navigation.

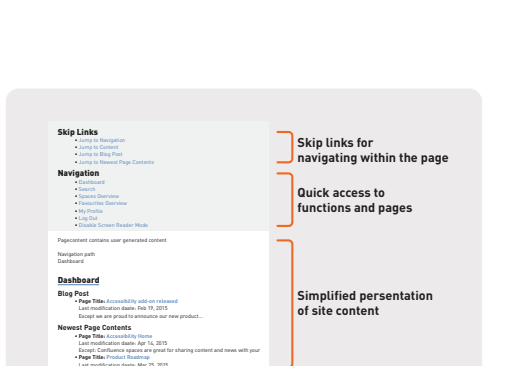


The user has control over the timing of content changes.

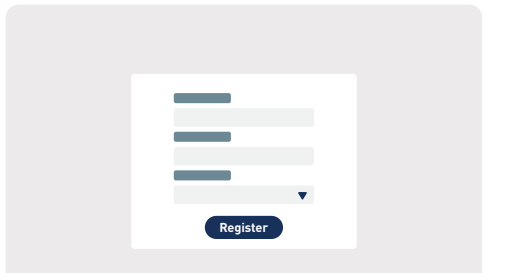


The user can interact with web content through voice commands.

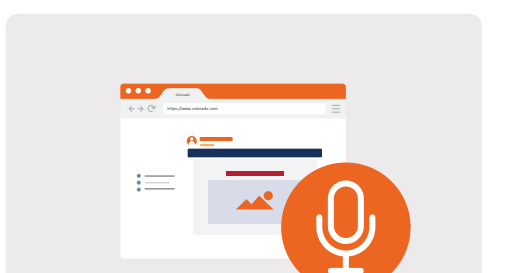
Assistive technology compatibility



All forms and files are readable by screen reader software, or an alternative means of accessing equivalent content is provided.
